THE BACKGROUND: Coconino County ITSP provides help desk support for more than 1,000 local government users, covering everything from desktops, laptops, printers, A/V equipment, and smart devices to networks, RFPs, and antivirus software. ITSP receives approximately thirty-five phone calls and logs about forty-five work orders (tickets) on an average day.



THE CHALLENGES: The technical service and support team at Coconino County had a reputation for not being able to satisfy its users' demands for support as technologies were changed and upgraded. Those users began calling the ITSP team "The Helpless Desk."

THE ACTION: Coconino County ITSP now requires its technical specialists to earn the HDI Support Center Analyst certification. To help specialists prepare for their certification exams, they are also required to take the HDI Support Center Analyst online course.

THE RESULTS: Over the past year, Coconino County ITSP turned its poor reputation around. Work order completion is up 25 percent and "below satisfactory" surveys are down nearly 80 percent. In addition, the team now adheres to customer service standards and customer-centric ideals.
